





William I (1066-1087)

• Started the building of the White Tower

Henry III (1216-1272)

Added the outer curtain wall

Edward I (1272-1307)

Changed the Tower into a mighty fortress

Henry VIII (1509-1547)

• Added the Queen's House

Queen Victoria (1837-1901) Added Wellington Barracks (Waterloo Block - where you can see the Crown Jewels today)






