



TO MAKE YOUR FLYING DOVE PUPPET

- 1 If you like you can draw on the shapes or colour them in first.
- 2 Cut out the body shapes.
- 3 Cut out the wing shapes and fold sharply on the dotted line.
- 4 Glue the wings to the body shapes in the marked spot.
- 5 Tape the lollystick to the inside of one of the body shapes, so that one end almost touches the bird's back and the other end sticks out beneath its tummy.
- 6 Glue the body shapes together.
- 7 Hold the lollystick and gently lift the bird up and down to make its wings flap.

Have fun playing with your flying dove!
