


A PALACE THAT BECOMES YOURS






RECEPTION & DINNERS


THE MAIN HALL

Up to 450 guests for a drinks reception and 300 guests for dinner and dancing.






THE UNDERCROFT


The space used to be the old drinking den for James I and provides the perfect atmospheric backdrop for drinks recepetion and entertainment.




THE MAIN HALL
