
Groups visiting the Tower of London will be able to experience a Victorian Christmas, with festive music played by the Southwark

PALACES ON FILM With the film tourism industry sky rocketing, we caught up with Filming Manager Binita Dave who lifts the curtain on why our sites are so popular within the industry and reveals areas of the palaces visitors can expect to recognise from the big and small screen. 1. 


