Staff wear red jackets. There may be staff wearing lanyards out of uniform.

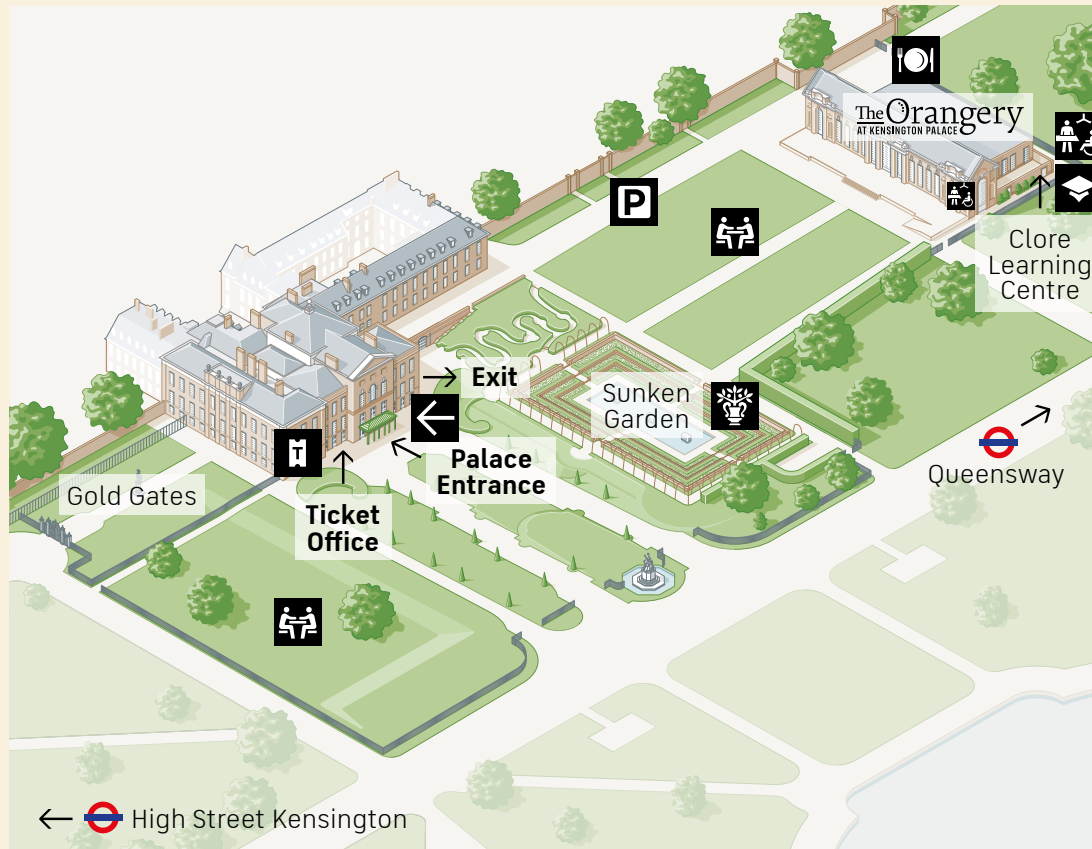
ARRIVAL

LAST PRINCESS OF PUNJAB



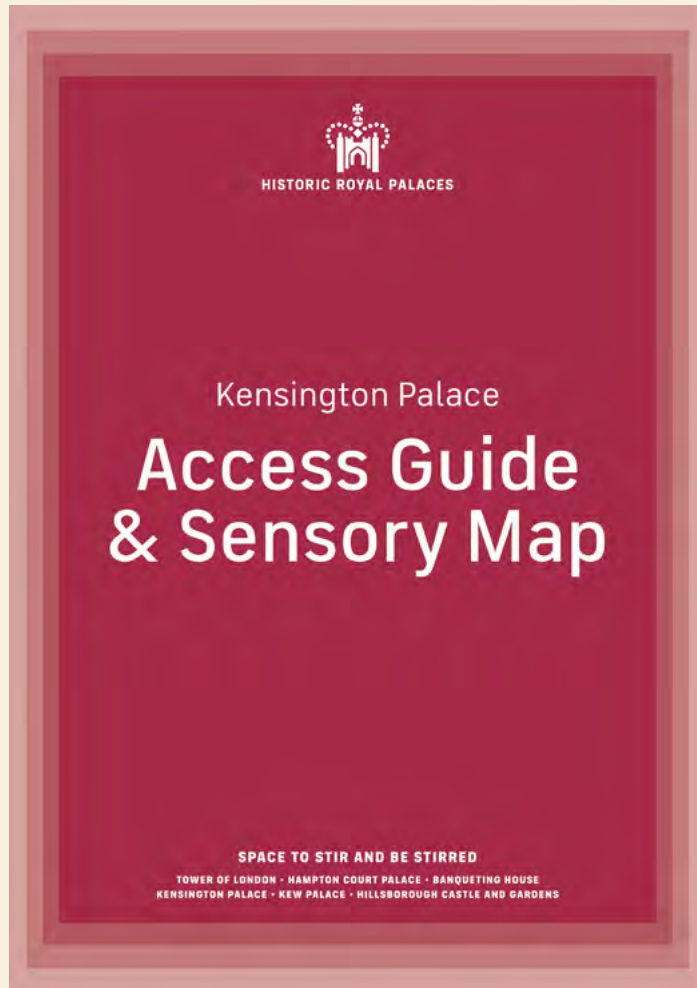
Our temporary exhibition, Last Princess of Punjab, will be open during your visit.
