Taking a tour of the Castle



GETTING STARTED

You will need a ticket to take a tour of Hillsborough Castle. A member of staff can help you with this.

It takes 20 minutes to walk from the ticket desk, through the gardens to the Castle. The walk is mostly up hill. If you are not able to walk this far, ask a member of staff for help. There is a car that can take you there. The car can carry up to 4 people and 1 wheelchair at a time.







While inside Hillsborough Castle, you must always be with a member of staff. A tour of the Castle lasts 45 minutes.

You cannot touch the furniture or artwork. You cannot take photos inside the Castle.

The first room where you start your tour is called the State Entrance.

This room may be dark.

The next room is called the Ante Room.

This room is small and may feel crowded.







The Red Room has very bright colours and lots of artwork on the walls.

The Dining Room is very large.

The Throne Room is very large with lots of space. There are bright colours and lots of artwork on the walls.









You will pass through Staircase Hall on your way to the next room.

The State Drawing Room is very large with lots of furniture. The room is very bright with lots of artwork on the walls.

The last room is called Lady Greys Study. It is small and has lots of artwork in the walls.
